

VETERAN FIRST-YEAR APPLICATION PROCESS

We are excited that you are considering Whittier College as the next phase of your journey! To streamline the process please complete the following 7 steps:

❖ 1. Complete a Whittier College Application (2 options available):

- > Option 1 Common Application: https://www.commonapp.org/explore/whittier-college
- > Option 2 Instant Decision: https://admission.whittier.edu/portal/counselorconnect
- ➤ It is FREE to apply either way!

❖ 2. You will also need the following to complete a Common Application (Option 1):

- > Secondary School Report from your college/guidance counselor.
- ➤ Two Letters of Recommendation. The first letter must come from a teacher who taught you in a STEM, Language Arts, or Social Sciences class. The second letter of recommendation may come from a teacher in any area of study or a counselor, coach, clergy, or employer/supervisor.
- Official high school transcripts reflecting coursework through the junior year for Early Action applications, and through the fall semester of senior year for the Regular Decision applications.
- Standardized Test scores (Optional)
- Military Transcripts (if applicable).

❖ 3. Complete your application by the deadlines:

> Fall Early Action

Application deadline: November 15 FAFSA deadline: November 15** Decisions sent: January 15 Enrollment deadline: May 1

> Fall Regular Decision

Application Deadline: February 1

FAFSA and Cal Grant (CA applicants) deadline: March 2**

Decisions sent: April 1 Enrollment deadline: May 1

❖ 4. Complete and submit your Financial Aid Application (FAFSA).

- ➤ You can complete a FAFSA as early as October 1st.
- > You must add Whittier to the list of recipients (our federal school code is 001342-00).
- Complete your FAFSA here: www.fafsa.org

❖ 5. Complete and submit a VA Benefits Application

- > You must apply for benefits directly through the VA using the VA Online Application (VONAPP).
- You can do so here: How To Apply For The GI Bill I Veterans Affairs (va.gov)

❖ 6. Schedule a meeting with a First Year Admission Counselor
