



## VETERAN TRANSFER APPLICATION PROCESS

We are excited that you are considering Whittier College as the next phase of your journey! To streamline the process please complete the following 7 steps:

❖ **1. Complete a Whittier College Application**

- It's FREE to apply! You can do so here: <https://www.whittier.edu/admission/transfer>
- For an instant decision application: <https://admission.whittier.edu/portal/transferappt>

❖ **2. You will also need the following to complete the traditional application option:**

- **One letter of recommendation** from a current or recent college professor.
- **Official college transcripts** from every institution you have attended.
- **Official final high school transcript** or official copy of your GED. This requirement is waived if you have earned your Associate's degree.
- Military Transcripts (if applicable).

❖ **3. Complete your application by the deadlines:**

- For Spring – Refer to [this](#) for updated dates, with Rolling Admission on a space available basis
- For Fall – [here](#), with Rolling Admission on a space available basis

❖ **4. Complete and submit your Financial Aid Application (FAFSA).**

- You can complete a FAFSA as early as October 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - It is helpful to complete your FAFSA before the priority deadlines for Spring and Fall.
    - For Spring – December 1<sup>st</sup>
    - For Fall – March 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - ***Deadlines change for each academic year but typically fall around the same time.***
- You must add Whittier to the list of recipients (our federal school code is 001342-00).

❖ **5. Complete and submit a VA Benefits Application**

- You must apply for benefits directly through the VA using the VA Online Application (VONAPP).
